

To the readers of this newsletter (I've met a few of you in person at our various events, or even worked with you while you were with our department): I just want to say thank you all for joining me in this journey!


This has been one heck of an adventure that has helped me to grow as a student, a future librarian, and as a leader. I can hardly wait to see what the future holds!


