To the Kutztown University Community:

It has been brought to our attention that there have been some threat-related incidents on campus recently that are insensitive to the diverse nature of our campus community.

We want to remind you that such incidents are intolerable. Our university is committed to promoting respect and inclusion for everyone regardless of race, religion or creed. All KU students, faculty and staff are expected to uphold the expectations of the institution. This includes creating an environment that is conducive for all students to maximize their educational experiences in a climate that is respectful of human dignity.

The discovery of any individuals involved in acts of intolerance (confrontation, verbal comments, graffiti, etc.) will result in immediate action by our Department of Public Safety & Police Services and the Dean for Student Services & Campus Life. Punishment could include suspension from the university and/or the filing of criminal charges.

We ask that anyone with information regarding such instances report them immediately to our Department of Public Safety & Police Services by calling extension 34001. The information can also be reported anonymously at extension 3TIPS.

Kutztown University has an outstanding reputation as a quality educational institution for people of all backgrounds and beliefs. The responsibility to maintain and expand that reputation rests with all members of our KU family. We encourage your suggestions toward making our campus a safe and welcoming place for everyone. Thank you.
