STUDY ABROAD IN LONDON JUNE 21-JULY 4 – KU-UK program
brochures are now available in the Music Office.

MUS 207 Music in Britain (3 credit hours), will be offered as part of the UK-KU program during the first summer session of classes. We will study music composed in Britain from the Renaissance to the present day, with emphasis on the musical culture of London. The course will include classroom study and visits to churches, museums, concert halls, and musical landmarks in London in addition to attendance at concerts and a musical. Costs for the program are estimated to be \$3038, which includes tuition, room, breakfast, and course costs including transportation and admission tickets, but does not include airfare and other meals. Talk to your parents over break about the benefits of international study (it looks great on a resume!) and convince them this is the perfect gift for you this year!
