Entrepreneurially Talented Teen Camp (ETTC) is unique. It utilizes the extensive talents of successful business leaders to present different topics of interest to high school students thinking about a career in business. The program integrates with the instructional program, usually through a business club or accounting or other business class. The weekend includes a variety of fun games such as Monopoly, MegaRaiders, Berks Billionaire, and other financial literacy games. The students also play the World Trade Game, a real-world simulation where they represent a country, are given resources and world trade rules, with the goal of ending the game with the most money in the world bank. Students also participate in team-building activities, and work together on a project to bring a product or service to market. The commercial they produce is posted on YouTube so that everyone can enjoy the effort that they put into the projects they worked on.

<i>Silver patron level</i>	For any person or company contributing \$2000 or more, they will be given a full page in the program for an inspiring message or an advertisement as well as thank you notes from 5 students able to participate due to their largesse..They will also be invited to the Friday Luncheon.
<i>Gold patron level</i>	For any person or company contributing \$3000 or more, they will receive a personal video from the group of 5 students both thanking them and showing them the entrepreneurial endeavor the team worked on during the weekend. They will also be invited to the Friday Luncheon.
<i>Platinum patron level</i>	For any person or company contributing \$5000, they will be given a seat of honor at one of the meals of the weekend, and will be asked to spend a few minutes sharing the story of their own organization's success to the whole group.
