



Behaviors which are abusive can include (but are not limited to): pushing, shoving and hair pulling, verbal or emotional abuse, isolation, threats to children and other family members, harm to pets, destruction of personal belongings, control of money and threats which put the victim in reasonable fear or bodily harm. ... ### How to Spot a Person of Violence

*Rigid sex roles:* "A man is the king of his castle."

"A woman must serve and obey."

*Unrealistic expectations:* expects perfection of you; must meet all of the person's needs.

*Quick involvement:* "I've never felt like this with anyone." A batterer comes on very strong, immediately wanting an exclusive relationship.
