CAMP DIRECTOR

Judy O'Connell-Lawes



Judy Lawes begins her 22nd season as head softball coach at Kutztown University. The 2008 season was a remarkable one for the Golden Bears, as KU set school records for

overall (48) and Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Eastern Division (22) wins. KU won the regular season PSAC East crown, and hosted both the PSAC and NCAA Middle Atlantic regional tournaments for the second consecutive year. The Bears finished third and third, respectively, in the tournaments. KU set single-season PSAC records in 17 team and 18 individual categories. Lawes was named KU Coach of the Year. Lawes has had a winning year in every one of her 21 seasons at KU. She led the Golden Bears to a record of 595-362-1, which ranks among the top 25 active Division II coaches. She recorded her 500th victory in a 7-6 win over Millersville in 2006. Among her wins, 278 have come against PSAC East foes. Lawes is Kutztown's winningest coach in school history, regardless of sport. Since 2000 alone, Kutztown has recorded 294 victories. Lawes has led the Golden Bears to all 11 of their appearances in the NCAA Division II Tournament in the school's history. She guided them to three-straight appearances in 1994-96 and then every year from 2000-08.

CAMP PHILOSOPHY

Players are grouped by age and ability to work in small groups. Pitchers will receive instruction covering all aspects of the windmill pitching motion, development of more speed and control and different pitches (drop, change-up, curve and rise ball.) Catchers will receive instructions on all aspects of fast pitch catching techniques (framing pitch, proper footwork, body positioning, hand location, throwing techniques for pickoff and steals, blocking the plate, game calling and all other defensive situations related to position). Campers will also work on proper mental preparation training habits, pitching & catching strategy and much more. Catchers will also have hitting instruction daily. The All-Skills Camp will cover softball theory and fundamental skills including hitting, bunting, base running, sliding, fielding by position and team defense. Demonstrations and practice drills will be conducted daily. The evening sessions include games.
