Coach Greer is in her second season as head lacrosse coach at Kutztown University.

A 2002 graduate of KU, Greer will play a vital role in the growth of the lacrosse program at Kutztown. She was a four-year letter winner on the KU field hockey team from 1997-2000. She earned her bachelor's degree in social work. She is also a 1996 graduate of Exeter High School.

Greer returns to KU from Gwynedd-Mercy College, where she was the head coach of the field hockey team. While there, she served as assistant coach and interim head coach of the lacrosse squad, intramural and facilities coordinator, and the senior woman administrator. Her field hockey team was an NFHCA Academic Award recipient each of her four seasons. Greer obtained her master's degree in school counseling at GMC in 2006.

Greer's first full-time coaching job came as an assistant field hockey and lacrosse coach at Earlham College in Richmond, Ind., in 2002.

Kutztown will play a non-conference schedule in 2008, joining the PSAC in 2009 alongside Gannon and Mercyhurst to make an 11-team league.
