**GOALS OF PROGRAM**

- Develop and strengthen women's leadership skills, creativity, and respect for diversity;
- Establish a network of women throughout the PASSHE and promote existing networks of women at each of the fourteen universities;
- Encourage mentoring relationships among women in the PASSHE;
- Provide for informal learning opportunities for students to interact with faculty members, staff, and administrators; and
- Help students develop campus projects to practice skills learned at the Institute under the direction of a mentor on their campus.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

In order to be considered for this distinction, each student applicant must:

- be available to attend the Leadership Institute in western PA from **Sunday, June 20, 2010 through Friday, June 25, 2010.** (Most costs are covered by the University.)
- have completed at least 30 credits by the end of the spring 2010 semester and have at least two semesters remaining prior to graduation;
- have a grade point average above or near 2.75; and
- demonstrate the desire to serve as a leader within campus and/or community organizations.

Applicants must complete and submit an application in its entirety by the date specified. An application will be considered complete when each item is submitted:

1. This completed application; and
2. Two supporting statements from members of the KU staff or faculty who are familiar with the applicant's potential for leadership within the Kutztown University community and beyond.
