## Welcome to Kutztown University of Pennsylvania!

In preparation for your arrival, we would like to provide you with a preview of what will take place upon your arrival. The International Orientation is mandatory for all incoming international students. Please plan your arrival date with this in mind.

The International Orientation is typically held three or four days prior to the fall and spring semester start dates. It is a great way to adapt to campus life before the semester begins. During the International Orientation, students receive a tour of campus, as well as their housing information (if on-campus housing was selected) and course schedule information. Other important sessions are also scheduled throughout the orientation to share information about university rules and policies, immigration matters, public safety, information technology, student services and campus activities, and health and wellness services, just to name a few. A shopping trip is also scheduled to ensure that students have the necessary household items that they were unable to bring with them from their home countries.

### Day 1

- Arrive at Kutztown University and check-in at the Office of International Programs, Stratton Administration Building, Room 204
- Tour the campus
- Move-in to residence hall (if on-campus housing was selected)
- Attend the *Welcome* dinner

### Day 2

- Optional: Shopping trip to Wal-Mart for necessary household items

### Day 3

- Morning: English Language Program testing (applies only to students who are conditionally admitted)
- Afternoon: Team builder activities (all incoming international students)
