The official GRE General Test is divided into three distinct sections: Quantitative Ability, Verbal Ability, and Analytical Ability. This practice test contains the Quantitative Ability portion.

This practice is comprised of **two 30-question** sections containing **quantitative comparison, arithmetic, algebra, geometry, and data interpretation questions**. Each question is multiple choice and measures your understanding of basic math skills and concepts, and the ability to solve problems of a quantitative nature. The section does not normally require any mathematical knowledge beyond the high school level.

The official GRE CAT is scored using a scale that compares your score to that of others taking the test. However, because this online test is for practice and diagnostic purposes, at the end, **you will receive your score out of a percentage of 100**. When you take the official GRE, the Quantitative Ability section will contain 28 questions. This online test is longer than the actual test in order to provide you with an **accurate gauge of your strengths and weaknesses on the Quantitative Ability portion**. This practice is an invaluable tool to help you **achieve the best score possible on the official test**. Good Luck!
