

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CHECKLIST

Pay Advanced Registration Deposit (ARD)

Pay the \$300 Advanced Registration Deposit through your MyKU portal (<https://myku.kutztown.edu>) or with Flywire at www.kutztown.edu/intlpayments. Use the network ID and password you received in your acceptance letter.

KU Email Account

Log into your KU email account. KU offices will only use this email address to contact you with important information about housing, billing, and other steps you must take before you arrive at KU. Log into the email account by going to www.kutztown.edu, clicking Current Students, and then Email Access. Use the KU network ID and password you received in your acceptance letter. Add @live.kutztown.edu to your ID to sign in.

Complete Student Visa Process

If you have to apply for a student visa or transfer your SEVIS record, submit the I-20 application and supporting financial documents. If you are applying for a visa, pay the SEVIS I-901 fee at www.fmjfee.com and then apply for a student visa at <https://travel.state.gov>. For more information, go to www.kutztown.edu/studentvisa. Notify the Office of International Admissions when you receive your visa.

Submit Requested Documents

Campus offices may request information. Requests are posted on MyKU on the KU Tasks tile, under To Do items. To view any messages, check Messages on the same tile.

Enroll in Payment Plan (optional)

Use projected costs provided online to enroll in a payment plan. Payment plan options are available beginning in April. To sign up for a payment plan, go to MyKU (<https://myku.kutztown.edu>) > KU Financial Account tile > Payment Dashboard.

JUNE: Check KU Email and MyKU

Submit Health Records

You will receive an email requesting proof of certain immunizations and health tests prior to your arrival at KU. The requirements must be complete at least two weeks before you arrive at KU.

Final High School / College Transcripts and Test Scores

Final high school diplomas/certificates or college transcripts are issued after graduation and/or your final semester. Ask your school counselor, college registrar's office, or national examinations council to send final official transcripts/national exam results to KU's Office of International Admissions.

Take Aleks Math Placement Assessment

Taking the Aleks Math Placement Assessment is mandatory for all new students. This will guarantee proper placement in a math course if your major requires it. Visit www.kutztown.edu/accepted to find the link for the Aleks Math Placement.

– Take CAPE Language Placement Assessment. You may earn up to 9 credits. Please visit www.kutztown.edu/modernlanguages (click on Placement).

– Submit Advanced Placement Scores. Timely submission will assure you are placed in the appropriate classes. Visit www.kutztown.edu/registrar (click on Student Information > New Student Information).

JULY: Check KU Email and MyKU

Register for New Student Orientation

In addition to New International Student Orientation, you will attend a general KU New Student Orientation program either online or in-person. A parent/family orientation program is also available. Register at www.kutztown.edu/orientation.

Bills Posted on MyKU

Bills are posted online only in MyKU (<https://myku.kutztown.edu>) > KU Financial Account tile > Payment Dashboard > Your Bills. Fall semester bills are online mid-July and due August 4.

Make Your "Intent to Attend" on MyKU

Once the bills are prepared, locate the double-sized tile Intent to Attend, change the NO to a YES and click Save.

Obtain Your KU I.D. Card

You will receive an email with instructions on how to obtain your KU ID card after attending orientation at www.kutztown.edu/kucard.

Select a Meal Plan

Starting July 3rd, select a meal plan by completing the Meal Plan Application on the MyKU Housing page. Students living in traditional style halls must select a MyTime Dining 24/7 meal plan option.

Bills Due First Week

Attend International Orientation

Attend the mandatory international orientation program that will be held the week before classes begin. Arrival and international orientation program dates are online at www.kutztown.edu/intlaccepted.

Attend Welcome Weekend

All new freshmen are required to attend Welcome Weekend as part of their orientation experience. Look for schedule information in your KU email.

Purchase a Parking Permit

Log in to your MyKU account (<https://myku.kutztown.edu>), click on Vehicle Services and follow the prompts. Visit www.kutztown.edu/parkingpermits for more information.
