ANNUAL REPORTS

Programs should submit annual reports on assessment conducted in AY 21-22 by September 30 2022. Reports should be uploaded to the appropriate folder (links on the next page). Reports should include the following information:

- SLOSs assessed
- Method of assessment
- N (sample size)
- Success criteria (ex: 75% of students will achieve 3 or higher)
- Summary of findings (was the success criteria met, analysis of the data)
- Plan to respond to the data (what will you do to continue improvement?)
- Notes on any changes made to the program that influenced this assessment process/result
