About the Services

All the services have one common goal—to provide excellent tools to help students succeed. Your library's faculty and staff are here 750 combined hours a week to assist you with your library service needs.

- Your librarians are here to help you with information literacy instruction, individualized research, navigating the databases, and effectively using the library's resources
- The Library also houses other units such as the Student Success Center, TRIO, Tutoring and the Writing Center

Physical/Electronic Reserves

Personal copies of books can be placed on Reserve in the library for students to borrow from the front desk. About the Building

Your library is a fine example of the Brick Brutalist style of architecture which is characterized by repeating angular geometries and external structural elements like the front support columns.

- 122,667 gross square feet
- 1,050 chairs for students
- 9 reservable study rooms
- **3 floors:**
 - **Top Floor:** Three computer labs, quiet zone, media, archives and group study areas.
 - **1st Floor:** Information desk, coffee shop, Writing Center, computer lab, leisure reading, main collection, reference collection, research consultation, and interlibrary loan. The shelves have been adjusted for ADA compliance.
 - **Ground Floor:** Teacher materials, Tutoring, Student Success Center, TRIO and our STEAMworks makerspace
- **The Balcony:** The front balcony is open for students to use in nice weather (sun up to sun down)
- **The Cow:** "The Elusive Sea Cow", on the second floor, was an art project by KU alumni
- **Study Rooms:** Individual and group study spaces available on all three floors
