Abstract: Join us over zoom as we celebrate newly acquired strategies and successes for online teaching as well as problem solve new challenges. Dr. Mark Wolfmeyer will begin by sharing a new strategy he is using in online teaching: personalized google documents as organized spaces for students to complete multi-faceted projects or term papers. Next, he will facilitate zoom "breakout rooms:" in small groups, participants will have the opportunity to share one success and one issue they are facing. Afterwards, the whole group will come together to report out successes and challenges. A final group discussion will focus on final course assignments as we gear up to conclude the semester.

About the speakers: Dr. Mark Wolfmeyer taught mathematics in secondary public schools before receiving his PhD in Urban Education from the Graduate Center, City University of New York. As a teacher educator in the Department of Secondary Education, he prepares future mathematics teachers and teaches educational foundations to undergraduates, master's, and doctoral students.
