Abstract: This CET presentation and discussion will focus on the practical use of Mediasite Desktop Recorder 2 to produce video or audio content in conjunction with a screencast. The presenter will show how to produce videos using Powerpoint slides and a pen tablet for writing on screen, but any software and internet browsers can be used within the screencast. This type of video content would be most suitable for teaching in asynchronous and flipped classroom environments, and provides a good option for instructors as a tool for uncertain and evolving teaching situations, such as what might be encountered in the upcoming fall semester.

About the speaker: Dr. Darren Achey completed his B.S. degree in chemistry from Pennsylvania State University in 2008 and received his Ph.D in chemistry from Johns Hopkins University in 2013. He will be beginning his 8th year at Kutztown University in Fall 2020. He began creating the video content discussed in this presentation in January 2020, never imagining how important the strategy would become a mere two months later. The videos were well-received by students in the Spring 2020 semester who commented how they still felt connected to the course.
