**Abstract:** As we prepare for the final exam week, this Faculty-led presentation and discussion will focus on ensuring the integrity of online exams. The presenters will share best practices, recommendations, and lessons learned when setting exams on D2L, proctoring online exams, and sending preparation instructions to students. They will discuss the advantages and disadvantages of LockDown Browser setting and using Zoom for proctoring exams. The presentation will be followed by the Q&A session.

**About the speakers:** All of our speakers are from the Dept. of Social Work. Dr. Juliana Svistova, an Assistant Professor, has an extensive experience teaching undergraduate and graduate level courses in fully online and blended formats.
