Abstract: Learning how to use Zoom is just the beginning. Being able to use Zoom EFFECTIVELY to teach, mirroring many of the classroom capabilities takes a while to figure out. Well, CJ Rhoads has learning about many of these advanced activities – often the hard way, by making mistakes. (Luckily her students are very forgiving.) If you want to be able to do these advanced activities without going through the same long and painful learning curve, join us for this informative session on advanced techniques when teaching with zoom. You will learn: how to see more of your students together; how to take advantage of a second monitor; tips to sharing your screen and having students share theirs; using the assignment folders in D2L to do participation grading more easily; using printscreens in Zoom to back up the assignment folders; using breakout rooms for team assignments and to proctor tests; when NOT to use breakout rooms; using the participants panel and the chat capability more fully; when NOT to use participants panel or chat, and making and editing recordings.

About the speaker: Dr. Rhoads is a Professor in the College of Business at KU. She received her D.Ed. in Educational Technology with a minor in Business Administration from Lehigh University, and her M.Ed. from Temple University in Educational Psychology focusing on Instructional Design. Her research interests include leadership development, business strategy, entrepreneurship, healthcare cost management, newly developed educational technologies, and integrative health practices. She is a highly sought-after speaker, author, and consultant on business strategy, leadership, healthcare and technology topics.
