Abstract: This session provides an overview of the Honors capstone requirement for KU Honors students and the expectations of Honors capstone faculty advisors. The material covers the specifics of each semester of the three-semester process, including the proposal, the independent studies, the WIPS, the Capstone conference, and the Capstone submission. Honors students value the mentoring relationships that result from the Capstone process and are thrilled when their advisors participate in the Honors extras, also covered, including the Honors senior banquet. Recent and current Capstones, Honors SLOs, and student Capstone awards will be highlighted.

About the speaker: Jennifer Schlegel (she/her), director of the Honors Program and associate professor of anthropology, earned her PhD in linguistic anthropology from UCLA. Schlegel has been teaching in the PaSSHE system since 2005 and has had the privilege of serving as director of the Honors Program since 2018.
