**Abstract:** Dr. Kronenthal has attempted to smooth his students' shift into online learning by maintaining many key aspects of his face-to-face classes, including synchronous interactive lectures and hand-written assessments. In this talk, he will discuss some of the ways he is using Zoom (including the whiteboard, breakout rooms, and chat features), D2L, and Adobe Acrobat to facilitate this transition.

**About the speakers:** Dr. Brian Kronenthal has been at Kutztown University since 2013, after earning his B.S. in mathematics from Lafayette College, and his M.S. and Ph.D. in mathematics from the University of Delaware. He has taught a wide variety of courses across the mathematics curriculum, from general education classes to challenging courses specifically for mathematics majors. His research interests are in Combinatorics, an area of mathematics related to enumeration.
