**Abstract:** Dr. Kronenthal will present from one of the auditorium-style classrooms in which he is teaching this semester using Zoom and the Sony camera. In addition to a demonstration and description of his teaching in a class where many students attend virtually, there will be plenty of time for questions and discussion.

**About the speaker:** Dr. Brian Kronenthal has been at Kutztown University since 2013, after earning his B.S. in mathematics from Lafayette College, and his M.S. and Ph.D. in mathematics from the University of Delaware. He has taught a wide variety of courses across the mathematics curriculum, from general education classes to challenging courses specifically for mathematics majors. His primary research interests are in Combinatorics, an area of mathematics related to enumeration. Dr. Kronenthal is the 2020 winner of the John P. Schellenberg Award for Excellence in Teaching and Learning.
