Abstract: In this talk, Dr. Palkendo and Prof. Tranotti will share their experience of creating D2L quizzes in a timely and effectively manner. In particular, they will focus on how to create questions in the Question Library and import test bank questions from different resources including those provided by publishers and questions created in Word and Excel files. Furthermore, they will discuss how to copy the Question Library or individual Quizzes to other course sections; how to set up the basic quiz parameters; and question types to watch out for.

About the speakers: Dr. Julie Palkendo, Associate Professor of Chemistry, has been using D2L Quizzes for over 10 years, but she is always learning new shortcuts and time-savers. Professor Steven Tranotti, Instructor of Computer Science & Information Tech, has been at KU for the past 3 years. He worked in the Hazardous Chemical Waste and Recycling industry for 15 years before going back to school for Computer Programming. He worked as an application programmer for Chubb Insurance Company for 9 years. While at Chubb Professor Tranotti received his MS degree in Computer Informational Systems. He taught various Computer Science and Information Technology courses at NCC before coming to KU.
