





Review Service

At the CDC, staff members engage with students one-on-one during Quick-Question Walk-In Hours to review resumes and cover letters helping students present their education and talents to prospective employers and graduate schools.

New this year was the option for students to upload their resume into KUCN for review and approval. The number of documents reviewed increased by 41%.

Certificate Programs

The two specially-designed, free, professional development certificates help students become stronger, more confident successful students and future employees!


Employer Engagement

KU Career Network (KUCN) is the primary online resource for preparing and connecting students and alumni with employers as well as on-campus opportunities. As of this year, the number of full-time listings increased 8%, internships increased 59%, and part-time positions increased 35%.


