- XXXXXX is an outstanding employee. She is very conscientious about the work that she does for the position of TVI. She submits all of her documents on time. She is wonderful with the students and the staff that she interacts with and she always has a positive attitude.
- Both novice teachers that I hired last year were ready for the work environment at a public school. They were receptive to suggestions and directives. Their mentors worked with them about the depth of knowledge needed for the instruction to be meaningful for the students, so they reviewed curricula. The mentors also worked with them on their pacing. The mentors worked with them on their responsiveness to suggestions or directives. So they adapted quicker.
