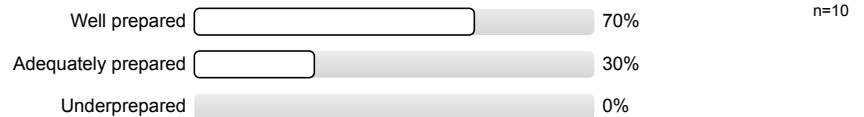

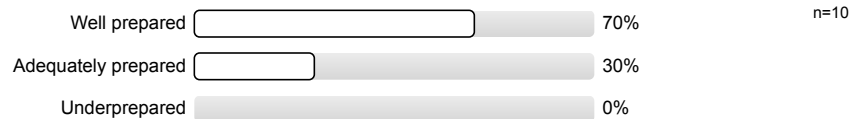

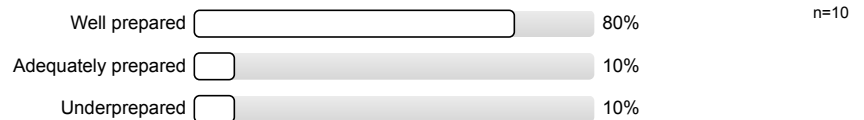
1.1) Rate your employee's preparation in the area of content knowledge.



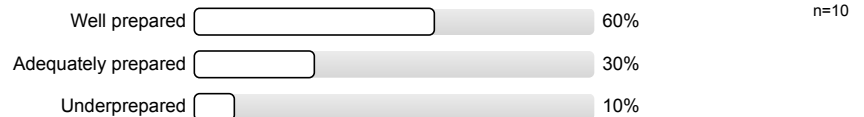
1.2) Rate your employee's preparation in the area of planning/instruction.



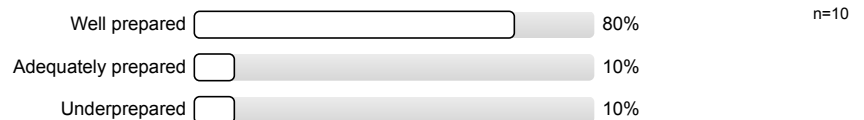
1.3) Rate your employee's preparation in creating an environment suitable for learning.



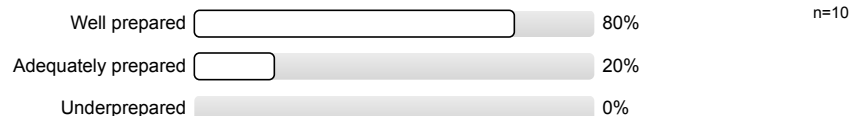
1.4) Rate your employee's preparation in the area of instructional delivery.



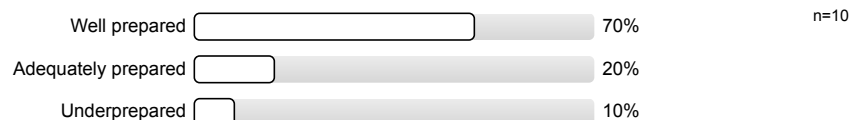
