Judging Day & The Prize

The Official Judging Criteria:

- **Aesthetic Appeal (The Showstopper):** Is it a true marvel? Judges will evaluate the overall visual impact, imagination, and festive themes.
- **Technical Skill (The Signature):** The precision of your decorating, neatness of the icing work, and attention to detail in the finishing touches.
- **Structural Integrity (The Technical):** Does the house stand proud? A sound construction that is stable and upright.

The winner will be crowned this year's **Star Baker** and awarded the coveted prize (and the eternal glory of a metaphorical Hollywood Handshake!).
