

## Student Learning Outcome (SLO) #4: Engage critically with creative or artistic works.

**Definition: Critical thinking** is a habit of mind characterized by the comprehensive exploration of issues, ideas, artifacts, and events before accepting or formulating an opinion or conclusion. **Creative thinking** is both the capacity to combine or synthesize existing ideas, images, or expertise in original ways and the experience of thinking, reacting, and working in an imaginative way characterized by a high degree of innovation, divergent thinking, and risk taking.

**This SLO is met in the following General Education categories: D – Understanding and Creating Ideas** – Courses in this category capture the process of imagination in the creation of aesthetic objects, environments, or experiences influencing and affecting one or more of the senses, emotions, and intellect. They also apply universal ideas through focusing on meanings of events and their impact on society, and exploring issues, artifacts, and events before accepting or formulating a position or conclusion.
