

This is a gentle reminder about the upcoming **deadline (end of January)** for proposal submission to the **12th interdisciplinary Undergraduate Research Conference in German Studies**, co-organized by Lafayette College and Moravian University, that will take place via Zoom on **SATURDAY, APRIL 1**.

We would like to encourage you to identify outstanding student research projects and guide your students through the application process.

We consider **proposals for research papers and posters**. Papers and posters can be presented in either **German or English**.

- \* Paper presentations may not exceed 15 minutes (2000 to 2500 words).
- \* Posters must include a thesis statement, a short reference to literature and primary materials, and a discussion of the methodology and results.

**The PROPOSAL should be of 250-300 words and must include:**

- \* The title of the paper or poster,
- \* a concise thesis statement,
- \* a short list of primary and secondary sources (bibliography), and
- \* anticipated findings.
