

WHAT TO BRING...

A LIST FOR YOUR ROOM

- Bedding for an extra-long twin bed (Twin XL)
 - Linens, pillow, blanket, bedspread
- Fan
- Trash/Recycling can(s) and trash bags
- Hangers
- Laptop/desktop
- Television*
- Flashlight & batteries
- Push pins
- Power strips
- Mini refrigerator (it may not exceed 3.2 cubic feet) or rented MicroFridge (one per room)
 - MicroFridge can be rented through mymicrofridge.com
- Stationary supplies (pens, pencils, paper, post-its, tape, stapler, paper clips, calculator, etc.)
- Rainwear/umbrella
- Light cleaning items (disinfectant wipes, dustpan and brush, vacuum*, paper towels, sponge, dish soap, etc.)

A LIST FOR THE BATHROOM

- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries and a tote (for carrying items to the shower)
- Personal appliances (i.e. hairdryer, curling iron, etc.)
- Shower shoes/flip-flops
- NOTE: Shower curtains are provided for all showers.
- For apartments & suites only:
 - Soap and soap dish
 - Toilet paper
 - Bathroom cleaning supplies (toilet cleaner and brush, shower cleaner, etc.)
 - Bathmat*

A LIST FOR YOUR LAUNDRY

- Laundry basket or bag
- Detergent, bleach, softener, etc.
- Quarters (not needed if paying with CleanCash app)
- Auto shut-off iron and ironing table (may only be used in the laundry room)

OPTIONAL AMENITIES

- Memo board for your door*
- Auto shut-off, single-serve personal coffee maker (i.e. Keurig)
- Electric, auto shut-off tea kettle (without hot plate)
- Floor and desk lights (no halogens)
- UL-approved bulbs for lamps
 - NOTE: University Place has no overhead lighting
- Rug and curtains if desired* (all windows have blinds)
- Decorative lights with UL approval
- Plants and small decorative items
- Snow shovel & ice scraper for residents with cars on campus

A LIST FOR APARTMENT KITCHENS

- 9amp microwave (microwaves provided in West Apartments)
 - NOTE: Microwaves are **ONLY** permitted in apartment kitchens, not bedrooms
- Cooking appliances such as: toaster, slow cooker, indoor/George Foreman-type health grill, air fryer, etc.
- Dinnerware such as: plates, cups, utensils, and bowls
- Kitchen cleaning products
- Trash/Recycling can(s) and trash bags
- Dishcloths, sponges, and dish soap
- NOTE: Golden Bear Village South & Honors kitchens contain a stove/oven and a full-size refrigerator. Golden Bear Village West kitchens contain a stove top (no oven), microwave, and a trailer-size refrigerator.

WHAT NOT TO BRING...

- NO Microwave oven → **permitted in apartment kitchens**
 - unless you rent a MicroFridge unit from mymicrofridge.com
- NO Toaster oven, toaster, or griddle → **permitted in apartment kitchens**
- NO Grills (outdoor or indoor/George Foreman-type) → **indoor grills permitted in apartment kitchens**
- NO Air fryers, slow cookers, or instant pots → **permitted in apartment kitchens**
- NO Pressure cookers
- NO Hot plate, heating coil, immersion coil, or exposed heating elements (i.e. traditional coffee maker)
- NO Electric frying pan or electric pots
- NO Halogen lamps, incandescent light bulbs, or neon lights (all lights must be UL approved)
- NO Air conditioner
- NO Space heater
- NO Animals (other than “toothless” fish)
- NO Candles or incense
- NO Reed or oil diffusers
- NO Alcohol bottles (not even for decoration)
- NO Bed risers or lifts
- NO Command strips (decorations may only be hung by push pins)
