

Social Security Rejection Letter for Driver's License

Access this information and links to all forms at the "Current International Students" section of www.kutztown.edu/international.

You can only receive a Social Security Number (SSN) if you have an offer of employment. If you want a Driver's License but do not have a SSN or a job offer, you will need to apply and get a rejection letter from the Social Security Office. If you do get a job in the future, you may apply for a SSN again. The application is free.

Social Security Eligibility Requirements:

- Present in the U.S. for at least 10 days
- Registered in SEVIS

Social Security Application Documents:

- Letter from the International Advisor
- Passport
- Visa
- Form I-20 / DS-2019
- Form I-94 (www.cbp.gov/i94)
- Social Security application (get this online at www.ssa.gov)

Process:

- Gather all documents listed above.
- Go to the Social Security Office.
 - Reading and Allentown are closest, but you can go to any Social Security Office.
- Keep your rejection letter in a safe place so you have it for your Driver's Permit application.
