

# **McFarland Student Union Policy 2000-0101**

### **GENERAL BUILDING POLICIES**

## A. Purpose

To ensure the proper use and maintenance of facilities of the MSU in order to provide the best possible environment to the University community.

# B. Scope

This policy applies to all student and non-student stakeholders of the McFarland Student Union.

## C. Definition(s)

## D. Policy and Procedure(s)

# • Illegal or Banned Items and Activities

- a. Illegal drugs, firearms, and gambling in any form is prohibited in the McFarland Student Union (MSU).
- b. Alcohol is prohibited in the MSU unless approved by the University President.
- c. Roller-blading, roller-skating, skateboarding, bicycle riding or similar activities are prohibited in the MSU.
- d. Use of candles, incense or any open flame is prohibited unless approved by Student Union and Commuter Services.
- e. Posting information in non-designated areas is prohibited unless approved by Student Union and Commuter Services.
- f. Removal of equipment or property from MSU is prohibited unless approved by Student Union and Commuter Services.
- g. Unauthorized postings or distribution of literature is prohibited in the MSU unless approved by Student Union and Commuter Services.

### Smoking

- a. Smoking is prohibited in the MSU
- b. All exterior entranceways are designated as smoke free with the exception of the north entrance as designated by the KU Smoking Policy.

### • Animals

- a. Animals or pets are not permitted in the building, unless:
  - 1. They are used to aid a person with a disability;
  - 2. They are part of a formal program and permission is granted by Student Union and Commuter Services;
  - 3. They are used for the purpose of law enforcement.

# • Equipment and Furnishings

- Equipment purchased, supplied or belonging to the MSU may not be removed from or loaned out of the building unless approved by Student Union and Commuter Services.
- b. If organizations move into another facility, equipment purchased, supplied or belonging to the MSU may not leave the building unless approved by Student Union and Commuter Services.
