Policies Governing Undergraduate Students Seeking Early Enrollment in Graduate Studies as a Graduating Senior at Kutztown University

Rational: Undergraduate seniors who have made application to enter a Graduate Studies program may be eligible to begin graduate studies early.

- Seniors with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 and/or special permission from the Dean of Graduate Studies, needing no more than 15 semester hours of academic credit to satisfy the requirements of their designated and declared baccalaureate degree may, with the approval of the chair(s) of the department(s) offering the graduate course(s), apply to the Dean of Graduate Studies for permission to supplement their undergraduate courses with graduate courses at either the 400 or 500 level.
- Such graduate credits do not apply toward meeting the requirements of any baccalaureate degree, nor shall they affect the undergraduate transcript or undergraduate GPA. Graduating seniors seeking early enrollment in graduate courses must be registered for all undergraduate courses required for graduation with the baccalaureate degree prior to enrolling in approved graduate courses during second cycle graduate registration.
- Graduate credit for a maximum of 6 semester hours of graduate work will be awarded only upon verification of completion of the baccalaureate degree.
- Tuition for a mix of undergraduate and graduate courses will be charged at the rate established for post-baccalaureate certification students.
- Employee waivers of tuition will not apply for graduate courses.
