Agency Name: Creative Health Services

Profile: Creative Health Services provides quality behavioral healthcare designed to empower and promote wellness for individuals, families, and communities. Creative Health Services believes in the ability of all people to recover from the difficulties they face. The focus is on every aspect of the person, including mental, physical, and spiritual health, which all play a role in overall wellness.

Field Placement Responsibilities: The specific program I will be working in is the Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP), which offers therapeutic intervention to adults with serious mental health diagnoses who experience significant impairment in their daily lives as well as high levels of emotional distress. I will attend weekly group and individual therapy sessions and shadow the therapist who is facilitating these sessions. I will develop a plan of treatment that is evidence-based, recovery-oriented, and tailored to the specific needs of the consumer for whom it is written as well as a group curriculum for conflict resolution that is evidence-based. Eventually, I will co-facilitate group psychotherapy sessions using generally accepted techniques employed in a manner consistent with ethical standards of practice.

Future Goals: After graduating in Spring 2021 with my BSW, I hope to obtain an entry-level position in the mental health field to start gaining experience and will potentially return to school for my MSW.

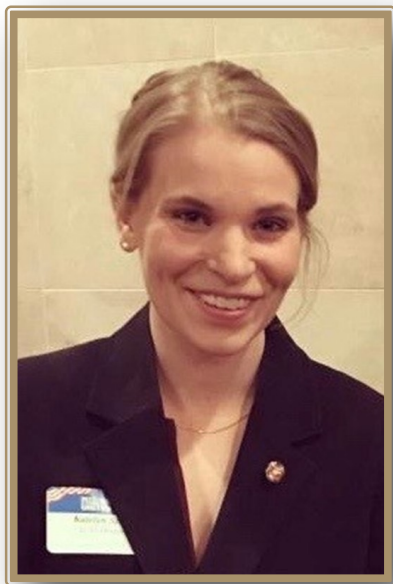
Future Goals: Identify my actions and behaviors to social work standards and values. Improve my communication skills. Better mediator & work with groups.

Agency Name: IU13



Profile: The IU13 is an education service agency that works with 22 public school districts in Lancaster and Lebanon county. They work to implement programs that target student populations in need and "improve student learning and achievement". IU13 Employees are expected to embrace the agency's mission to "Provide services, supports, and solutions that make a difference to all learners and our community".

Field Placement Responsibilities: I am working at the Fairland location in Manheim, Pennsylvania as a paraeducator in a special needs classroom. My classroom consists of 6 students, 4 males and 2 females, who suffer from a range of different cognitive disabilities. As a paraeducator, my role is to help support both the teachers and students in their learning experience. I monitor the children and provide educational and emotional support throughout the school day, as well as ensure safety, provide behavior management skills and conflict resolution interventions, initiate restraint procedures when there is a danger to self or others and help plan and implement activities. I also document the student's daily behaviors, interactions and educational progress all while utilizing trauma informed care.

Future Goals: I hope to work with families, at school & in the home - to provide children & parents with the necessary tools to help develop well educated, supported, financially stable & resource rich communities.

Agency Name: Co-County Wellness Services.

Profile: Co-County Wellness Services is an agency that provides free, preventative care to the community through service, education, and advocacy. This agency works to prevent and treat HIV/AIDS, other sexually transmitted diseases, and Teen Pregnancy. The agency provides case management, testing, treatment, and counseling to individuals in the community experiencing these challenges.

Field Placement Responsibilities: The responsibilities of a contact tracer at Co-County Wellness Services include reaching out to individuals who have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Once the individual is reached, the contact tracer requests that they quarantine and report any symptoms they may experience. This is made easier through software called Sara Alert, which allows those who are enrolled to be monitored daily for symptoms. It is the responsibility of the contact tracer to enroll contacts in this system. The contacts may also be monitored daily by the contact tracers themselves. It is the contact tracer's responsibility to also keep accurate notes on interactions with contacts, broker necessary resources, and practice confidentiality throughout this process.

Future Goals: Provide information and resources regarding sexual health education to youth. Many schools have a lack of comprehensive sex education. I hope to make a positive contribution towards changing this in the future.

Agency Name: Compassus Hospice

Profile: My internship is at Compassus Hospice in Leesport, Pennsylvania. Their mission is "to honor life and offer hope to individuals facing a life-limiting illness by supporting them with compassion, integrity, and excellence." The four levels of care provided to residents of the Berks County area include routine, respite, general inpatient, and continuous.

Field Placement Responsibilities: At Compassus Hospice, my role is to observe their company's Social Worker as she makes calls to her clients and local resources, documents information into the online database and conducts new client assessments and re-evaluations during home visits.
