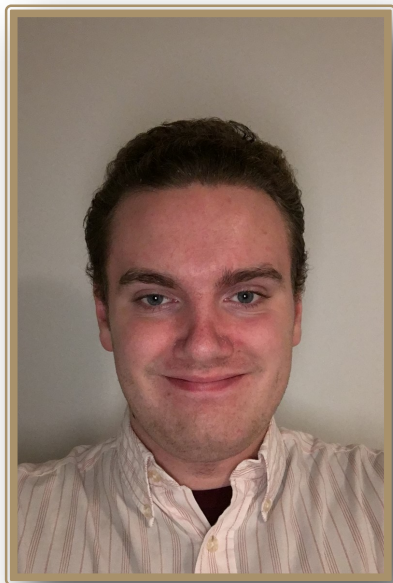


**Agency Name:** Advantage Home Health - Pottsville



**Profile:** Providing home health, hospice, nursing, and bereavement services to elders and families regarding end-of-life care and counseling.

**Field Placement Responsibilities:** Shadowing agency social workers in order to learn organizational norms and responsibilities, assisting with brokering to resources and showing warmth, empathy, and genuineness during sessions. Assisting clients gaining access to needed resources through tertiary agencies that can improve their quality of life, and documenting monthly updates toward different clients.

**Future Goals:** My future goals are to use the knowledge I have learned here and in my previous work with children to help individuals and families meet their needs, remain safe, and maintain long-term healthy development.

**Agency Name: Aspire to Autonomy**

**Profile:** Aspire to Autonomy is a human trafficking organization dedicated to improving the lives of survivors of human trafficking. Aspire to Autonomy strives to initiate, empower, and support survivor's path to recovery. Aspire to Autonomy achieves their mission by advocating, educating, and bring awareness about human trafficking to the community of the Lehigh Valley.

**Field Placement Responsibilities:** As an intern at Aspire to Autonomy, I am involved in the Ambassador Program, Act 197 planning and production, and Communication department. This year I will be involved with the Ambassador program including engaging, recruiting, and intervening with Ambassadors while assessing and evaluating the Ambassador program and surrounding factors. I will implement new policies and practices to improve the Ambassador program. I will work with the communication department to produce content, bring awareness, and promote our online presence. I will work with the Act 197 committee to advocate for the rights of human trafficking survivors, advocate for the increasement of fines, canvas local businesses, and advocate for the enforcement of Act 197.

**Agency Name: Reading School District**

**Profile:** Social workers identify barriers that interfere with students' educational success and seek to mitigate them. Many efforts are pointed toward working with students, families, and the school to identify specific needs and to help connect students/families to resources. Three areas of focus are homelessness, attendance, and mental health/crises.

**Field Placement Responsibilities:** I will be responsible for completing daily school activities and tasks. I will be working closely with the social worker through attending and participating in scheduled meetings with staff, reviewing student data (such as attendance and grades), and attending group meetings with students and the social worker. I will also be collaborating with the social worker to lead an after-school program called Aevidum. This is a way that social workers can engage students and encourage them to help their peers. Another responsibility I have as an intern is to manage and create an inventory for the Reading Knight's Closet. They receive various donations from multiple sources and it has been a great resource for students.

**Future Goals:** I hope to obtain my MSW, my license, and eventually work in adoption/foster care or school social work.

**Agency Name: KidsPeace Residential Program**

**Profile:** KidsPeace residential program focuses on providing therapy, stability, and education to children and teens that have experienced trauma. The residential program provides a combination of intensive therapy and therapeutic recreation which allows the clients to heal and process their trauma in a safe, stable, and therapeutic environment.

**Field Placement Responsibilities:** At KidsPeace Pioneer Center, I observe and conduct individual and family therapy. My responsibilities include attending weekly meetings with each client's treatment team to discuss the progress, future discharge goals, and after care services needed at discharge. I strive to build a positive rapport and develop a therapeutic relationship that allows clients quality therapy while in treatment.

**Future Goals:** My future goals are to become a licensed social worker, and work in the mental health field. I will combine my clinical experience with my creative background to provide artistic therapeutic approach to care.

**Agency Name:** *Aspire to Autonomy, Inc.*



**Profile:** ASPIRE's mission is to provide an environment of safety, healing, and empowerment that will equip victims of trafficking with the services and programs that are essential to their pursuit of independence.

**Field Placement Responsibilities:** Some of my roles and responsibilities include advocacy and education efforts to the community, facilitation of trainings, and working closely within the Communications Department to advertise events and to get support from the media. This year ASPIRE hopes to open a safe house to host victims of human trafficking which will allow me to utilize Case Management skills while working 1 on 1 with clients.

**Future Goals:** My future goals include: obtaining my MSW, working within the criminal justice system with adolescents, and to continue being involved with the trafficking movement.

**Agency Name: Street Medicine Tower Health**

**Profile:** The Street Medicine Program provides care to individuals experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness. They go into the community and meet clients where they are to provide care. The team also works to help clients get appointments and medications and advocates on their behalf.

**Field Placement Responsibilities:** This internship will work alongside the Street Medicine team to provide social work services to individuals experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness. I will aim to address any unmet social needs and provide resources for referral when necessary. This internship will also provide the opportunity to observe both inpatient and outpatient social work with the Reading Hospital's care management department.

**Future Goals:** I plan to get my LSW after graduation and continue to work on a macro level in an organization. Someday, I would love to teach social work at a community college.



**Agency Name: Aspire to Autonomy**

**Profile:** Aspire to Autonomy is a non-profit in the Lehigh Valley that advocates for human trafficking survivors. Their goal is to create a safe environment that fosters healing, empowerment, and autonomy through services and programs.

In the Act 197 committee, my role is to talk educate business owners about the enforcement of Act 197. I am also Aspire's social media manager.

**Future Goals:** I plan to pursue a career in social work related to behavioral health, and will continue to consider returning to school to earn my DSW.

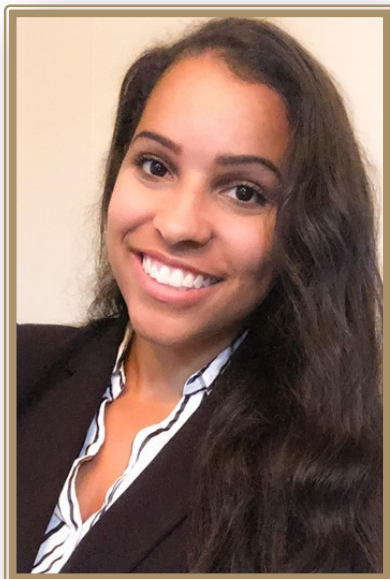

**Future Goals:** In the future, I hope to work with populations that struggle with mental health, sexual assault survivors, and the LGBTQ+ community.

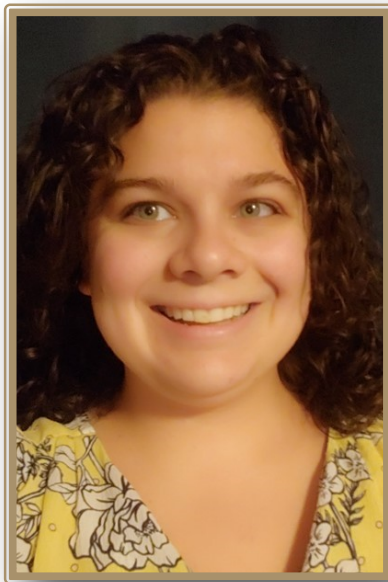

I will participate in the intake process for assessing new residents and I will also implement service plans, safety plans and behavior plans. While working within The Truth Home, I will be utilizing a strength based approach on all the work I do.

**Future Goals:** My future goals are to work as Behavior Health Specialist at either a school or hospital. I plan to take my licensure exam and receive my LSW soon after graduation.

**Agency Name:** Kutztown University Social Work Department



**Profile:** The Kutztown University Department of Social Work is conducting a research study titled “Access to Mental Health Services in Rural Pennsylvania”. This study focuses on the vulnerable populations of children 18 years and younger and older adults 65 and older; our team is explore the barriers service providers and users face when obtaining services in rural populations.

Some of my responsibilities this semester will include interviewing sources, such as Indigenous leaders of grassroots social movements, writing articles on social, environmental, and/or economic justice topics, and summarizing journal research and special events. Within my internship I plan to further investigate topics including Indigenous Peoples and the environment, as well as land rights, sovereignty, self-determination, cultural/language preservation, and intergenerational knowledge transfer.

**Future Goals:** In the future, I plan to pursue the emerging field of ecosocial work. I would like to empower and collaborate with Indigenous Peoples to defend their rights and protect the biodiversity of their lands.

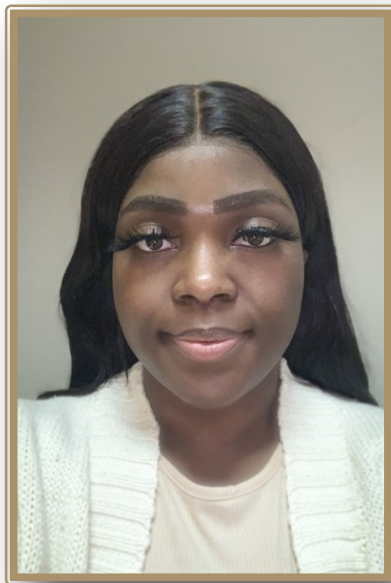
**Future Goals:** My future goals are to work with veterans who need assistance finding services and those who have a mental illness. Eventually, I would like to obtain my LCSW.

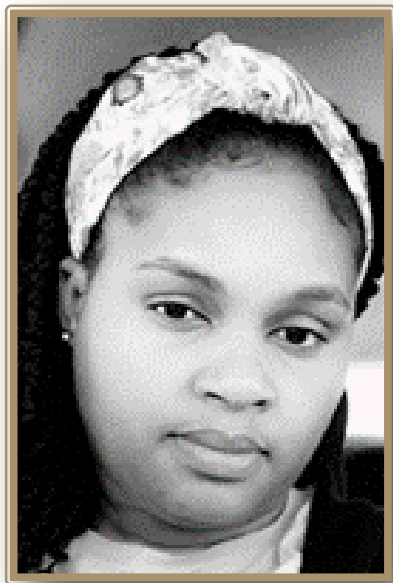

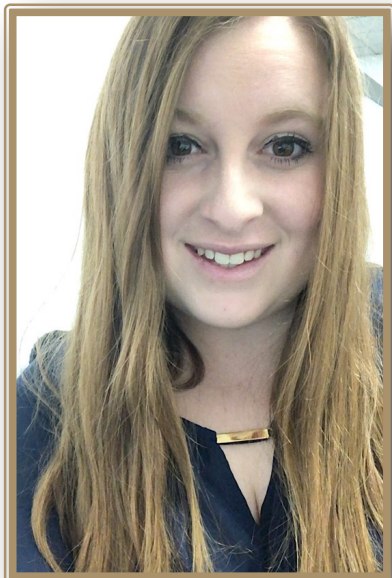
