### Description:

This leadership experience provides students with an opportunity to participate in the student conduct process to help ensure a fair and equitable student conduct system is maintained and upheld for the campus community. As a member of the University Conduct Board (UCB), student representatives are responsible for serving at hearings in cases of alleged student misconduct. As one of three representative groups serving on UCB along with faculty and staff, students share an equal role and voice in determining whether or not an accused student has violated the Code of Conduct based on the relevant facts and evidence presented at hearings.

### Requirements:

Student representatives to the University Conduct Board are required to meet the following requirements:

- Participate in UCB training and orientation.
- Be in good standing with the university (academic and conduct).
- Willing to participate in 3-5 hearings per semester.
- Have scheduled availability to participate in hearings.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality of all student information and student conduct proceedings.
- Willingness to serve for a minimum of one (1) year.
- Minimum GPA of 2.0

### Statement of Interest:

Applicants are required to write a statement of interest that outlines why they are interested in serving as a UCB representative and why they would be effective in this capacity. Statements should not exceed 1 double spaced, typed page.
