

Media Container Embedding

We have created a component in Ingeniux that allows for embedding various media. Currently, these include:

- Candid Career (Career Center video series)
- Image
- MediaSite
- Spotify (see *Spotify embedding walkthrough*)
- Vimeo Video
- YouTube Video


After creating the media container:

For an image, simply choose the image asset you want to include.


For a video, select the appropriate choice (Candid Career, MediaSite, Vimeo, YouTube) from the Create New Component field. *in this example, we are showing how to do YouTube. Each type of video will have a similar code within its URL that is used.*

Go to YouTube, find the video you want to embed. We are choosing the KU Good to be Golden video.

https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JKpDYAbP_CM. Copy the youtubeID of your video, our video ID is **JKpDYAbP_CM** (this is the string of characters after “watch?=”) (see screenshot).



In Ingeniux, after finding the Media Container and YouTube Video Partial component you are using, paste the YouTube ID, leave the **Playlist? Click to enable** checkbox blank, then add the title of the playlist into the Accessibility Title field.
